# Project Objectives and Implementation

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## PROJECT OBJECTIVES

### **The Rotary Foundation approved global grant funding to be used for the following project objectives:**

To create the background for sustainable and systematic suicide prevention by:

1. Developing the local community-based suicide prevention model derived from the algorithm of communication and cooperation among the local institutions at the front line of suicide acts, attempts and intentions with the help of the experts from academic institutions;
2. Implementing the model in selected 11 Municipalities by series of structured training addressed to the front line institutions (police, healthcare, education, social care, fire brigade, emergency, Municipality administration) as well as local communities and NGOs enabling them to act in an effective and coordinated way in suicide related emergency situations and have effective prevention tool. The Municipalities were selected based on statistical data from 2011-2016 years and the initiative of local administrations and Rotary clubs;
3. Supervisions for persons involved in trainings and implementation of suicide prevention model in the Municipality;
4. In cooperation with administrations of selected Municipalities enhancing accessibility of psychological help and elaboration of the model;
5. Monitoring and evaluation of the project implementation.

Inhabitants (total lives 353.110) in 99 elderships will benefit when functioning suicide prevention system and accessibility to psychological help will be implemented in territory of 11 Municipalities of Lithuania.

#### **Describe the progress you've made so far.**

1. Research of the situations in 9 participated municipalities was realized. Local suicide prevention group was created in each municipality, legally authorized by the decree of the municipal administration director. Standing on the research results, human resources, intentions to participate in problem solving of all local institutions, involvement of the local Municipalities leaders and cooperation with the administrations of the Municipalities suicide prevention models was drafted during discussions between members of local suicide prevention group in each Municipality. Now already in 6 Municipalities' suicides prevention algorithm was approved by the Councils and became legally used in the territory of the Municipality.
2. Training of "gatekeepers" how to act, react, help when suicide risk appears or after suicide happen (at least 6 groups in each municipality) took part in period OCT 2018 – APR 2019. 1370 persons (social care workers, firefighters, community leaders and representatives, school staff, teachers, policeman's, church representatives and NGO members, medical staff and psychologists) was trained. Each participant received 8 hours certificate "Suicide Risk Assessment and First Psychological Assistance" issued by the Lithuanian University of Health Sciences Department of Health Psychology.
3. As was planned after 6 months from trainings supervisions already started in 3 Municipalities with involvement of medical staff, psychologists, professionals of personal and public health care, members of local suicide prevention group or members of crisis management group.
4. In 2 Municipalities individual psychologist consultations started on FEB 2019 for residents who are at risk of suicide or lost their loved ones after suicide happened. Order No. V-859 of the minister of Health of the Republic of Lithuania "Approval of the Description of the Procedure for Assistance to Suicide Victims Suffering from Suicide and Sufferers of Suicide Crisis" came into force since 1 FEB 2019, which is intended to regulate specialists' responsibilities while working with suicidal people. Accordingly, elaborated drafts or

approved early by the Council's algorithms for Municipalities must be corrected, to fill in responsibilities of the medical doctors described in several steps of the algorithms. Team of the psychologists, working in the project, organized consultations between themselves and proposed corrections of the algorithms.

5. Monitoring and evaluation. The aim of the study was to find out the previous experiences of trainees with regard to suicide prevention, to clarify the subject's attitudes on this topic and to evaluate the change in knowledge before and after the training. The study was conducted in 8 Municipalities (Anyksciai, Druskininkai, Marijampolė, Panevėžys, Pasvalys, Silute, Tauragė and Vilkaviskis) where the trainings of the project was organized. One study group from each Municipality was randomly selected. The survey was carried out by means of a questionnaire before and after training in paper questionnaires. In sum, 172 specialists participated in the evaluation. Figures, tables and conclusions are presented as an attachment in Supporting Documents.
